# Spare clothes

Just a reminder that we have been trying to think of ways we could be more environmentally friendly, and were thinking it would be great if you could send in a reusable waterproof bag if you're able to, that we could send wet clothes home in. This would greatly reduce the amount of plastic nappy bags we're sending home. Thank you to those of you who have already done this.

## **Packed lunches**

We are excited to be working with HALO (Healthy Active Little Ones) from East Sussex County Council, and part of this will involve them supporting us with making healthy choices which are mostly low cost, no cost. Part of this will be encouraging children to eat healthily, and thank you for sending in healthy packed lunches. We all love seeing them and they always look so delicious. Bearing this in mind, we can provide water to drink at lunch time, as a healthy alternative to juices and smoothies which have a high sugar content. Also a little reminder to please chop into halves or quarters any blueberries, grapes, party sausages or other fruit or vegetables which are smaller than a two pence piece as children can choke on these.

We appreciate that its difficult when you need to go to work and you haven't got childcare, but we are trying to prevent the spread of illness between us all.

Could we please also remind you, as per our illness policy, children must not attend preschool if they have been vomiting or had diarrhoea until **at least 48 hours has elapsed since the last attack.** This is to try to prevent the spread of illness amongst the children and staff at Preschool, as much as we can.
