Coughs and sneezes

We are into the cold and flu season. While we appreciate that everyone catches colds, and we can't really avoid coming into contact with those who have them, could we please remind you not to send your child in if they have a high temperature. www.nhs.uk states that a high temperature in children is 38c or more.

Could we please also remind you, as per our illness policy, children must not attend preschool if they have been vomiting or had diarrhoea until **at least 48** hours has elapsed since the last attack. This is to try to prevent the spread of illness amongst the children and staff at Preschool. It's also not nice for little ones to be sent in when they're not feeling 100%.

SENCO

Hello everyone, part of my role as Deputy Manager is to be the settings Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO), and I have been very busy completing a Level 3 qualification in this. I'd just like to introduce myself as the SENCO for the Preschool and say that if you have any questions or concerns at all, I'm here either on the end of the phone, via messenger, email or in person to listen and give advice on services available that may be helpful to you and your family. Spare clothes

We are continuing to explore and make the most of our environment outside, in all weathers. The weather is turning colder and we all love looking at any ice, frost

and making the most of different weather conditions. As usual, please send in your children wrapped up warm in layers, coats, wellies and waterproofs if you have them. Could you also please ensure your child has plenty of spare clothes with them in a named bag at Preschool.

Just a reminder that we have been trying to think of ways we could be more environmentally friendly, and were thinking it would be great if you could send in a reusable waterproof bag if you're able to, that we could send wet clothes home in. This would greatly reduce the amount of plastic nappy bags we're sending home. Thank you to those of you who have already done this.

Packed lunches

A reminder to please chop into halves or quarters any blueberries, grapes, party sausages or other fruit or vegetables which are smaller than a two pence piece as children can choke on these. We do also advocate healthy lunches and provide milk and water at lunchtime for drinks.
