## End of session pick up and morning drop off


A reminder to all parents to please pick up your children on time at the end of their session. A late collection fee of £1 per minute will be charged from the time your child's session ends until they are collected. This is stated in our policy, which can be viewed on the preschool's website. We understand that sometimes things happen, so if, for any reason, you are going to be late to collect your child, please let us know as soon as possible.

Our sessions begin in the mornings either at 8.45 am (Rise and Shine Club) or 9.30 am. We try hard to work our way around the funding requirements set out by the Local Authority, and to also ensure that the preschool is able to survive financially. To help us to do this, we offer our Rise and Shine Club at a charge of £4.50 per day. If you are not signed up to do Rise and Shine, but wish to drop your child off anytime between 8.45 and 9.30, as an ad hoc session, we will add this to your next invoice.

## Rising 5's

A quick reminder to all parents/carers of children who will reach the age of 4 on or before 31 August 2026 that the deadline for applying for a school place for September 2026 is 15 January 2026. Children whose parents apply after the deadline are much less likely to be offered a place at their preferred school, even if they already have an older brother or sister there, so it is very important to apply before the deadline.


## Christmas Hamper

Once again, thank you for allowing us to look after your children, they are all amazing, we feel very lucky.


